

ST. CATHERINE OF SIENA PARISH HOSTS WORLD COMMUNITY DAY

"The World Within Our Neighborhoods" is the theme for a regional gathering Oct. 23 from 9 a.m. to 2 p.m. at St. Catherine of Siena Parish Hall to recognize World Community Day. The gathering is cosponsored by the St. Catherine Women's Guild and The Norwich and Willimantic units of Church Women United. The day will include a ceremony celebrating the role of the Christian faith in the global village at the turn of the century. Through stories, colors, symbols, and music the gathering will shape new ways of being in relationship with each other and with God. Prayer leaders will include Native American, Caucasian, African-American, Asian, and Hispanic women.

Afternoon workshops will be led by representatives from the State Board of Church Women United, an ecumenical movement that brings together Protestant, Roman Catholic, Orthodox, and other Christian women in the United States and Puerto Rico.
